

Connection of ICF-categories, assessment categories “IMPECD” and PAS(R)-statements

Category ICF	Gathered information <i>mainly</i> * of assessment category...
Health condition (diseases, disorders and injuries; influencing functioning)	1 - Client history
Body Functions & Structure (impairments; functioning)	3 - Behavioural - Environmental 4 - Clinical status
Activity (limitations; functioning)	2 - Diet history 3 - Behavioural - Environmental
Participation (restrictions; functioning)	1 - Client history
Environmental factors (positive/negative; influencing functioning)	1 - Client history 2 - Diet history 3 - Behavioural - Environmental
Personal factors (positive/negative; influencing functioning)	1 - Client history 2 - Diet history 3 - Behavioural - Environmental

* other assessment categories can be helpful, too.

Both ways – the ICF-scheme or the assessment categories “IMPECD” – can be used to collect data during the assessment. The next step is to formulate the Dietetic Diagnosis via PAS(R)-statements.
